

F-Gas Regulations



What are F-Gases?

Fluorinated greenhouse gases (F-Gases) are a group of chemicals containing fluorine that have been proven to contribute to global warming. Their effect can be much greater than carbon dioxide as they trap heat if released into the atmosphere. These substances known collectively as HFC's are currently used in most commercial and light industrial refrigeration systems.

How does it affect me?

EU changes to the 'Fluorinated greenhouse gas (F-Gas) regulation (EU) 517/2014 include the phasing out of HFC's and product bans and usage restrictions. If you use refrigeration and air conditioning systems in your business then this affects you.

HFCs are the most common type of F-Gas and are mainly used as the refrigerant in air conditioning and commercial refrigeration systems. Therefore, all users of refrigeration and air conditioning equipment have responsibilities for the F-Gas they have in their mechanical heat pump or cooling systems.

For the majority of uses they must be checked and serviced at least annually, for more heavy duty equipment this may mean bi-annual checks or the installation of fixed leak detection systems.

Determining exactly how this applies to individual systems can be a little complicated, so we are here to provide specialist advice to assist you in meeting your legal responsibilities
