

Company Policy Statement for the Protection of the Environment.

This will be achieved by ensuring:

- That our staff are fully aware of the environmental issues and associated legal requirements that affect their work, this awareness will be promoted by training and development of all persons within the business and adopting skills exchange across team members.
- That our customers and business partners are kept up to date with current legislation and regulations, industry best practice, and technological advances.
- That refrigerants will be handled by competent persons and where applicable will be reused or returned for reprocessing / destruction. Records will be kept of both new and reclaimed refrigerant to provide full traceability.
- All materials that are removed from installations will be properly dealt with; this includes but is not limited to packaging materials, metals, refrigerants and oils.
- Material usage methods will be designed to eliminate or minimise wastage.
- Risk assessments and method statements will consider environmental issues alongside health, safety and actual tasks.
- Resources used by the company such as electricity, gas and fuel for cars and vans will be monitored and energy efficiency will be a primary consideration when purchasing such equipment as heating / air conditioning systems and vehicles.
- Recycling of products will be considered and implemented wherever reasonably practical.
- The consideration and use of renewable technologies will be promoted both internally and to our customers.

This policy will be reviewed annually in conjunction with an Environmental Impact Review, to consider whether technical innovation via process changes, control mechanisms, more efficient use of materials or material substitution can lead to a lower environmental impact and or reduced risk of pollution.

Our goal will be to reduce in real terms the impact our business has on the environment year by year.
